## Not Intimidated

*"I see heaven open and the Son of Man standing at the right hand of God." At this they covered their ears and ...dragged him out of the city and began to stone him. –Acts 7:56-58*

Stephen knew it wasn't going to go over well. You don't just walk into a lions' den and impugn the character of lions. A mob mentality is never calmed by condemning it. It only rages stronger. Stephen understood what happens when you accuse the self-righteous of unrighteousness.

From a practical standpoint, Stephen's decision to go out in a blaze of glory seems pointless. He had no chance of appeasing his rabid opponents, and his lonely, dissenting voice would never speak again. His sacrifice wasn't going to change anything, and it ensured that he would never have another chance to change anything. The whole event appears futile to us. It seems like such a waste.

But Stephen's witness stands for us today, some two thousand years later. After he preached a searing message that day in Jerusalem, he preached a visual message with his death. And Stephen's visual message still moves us even today. We are reminded that truth is more important than life, that the Spirit is poured out through uncompromising faith, and that our love for God must always be stronger than our fear of human beings.

The Jewish leaders were convinced that Stephen was a blind fool. But Stephen literally saw heaven opened. Before Stephen began to speak, he had already made a decision about what would fill his gaze: the approval of God, not the approval of men. Stephen knew where to fix his sight.

What fills your sight in this world—a vision of God or the opinions of human beings? Which has a greater influence on you, especially in moments of crisis? It is normal for Christians to experience opposition to their faith. It is sad when that opposition alters their stand (causes Christians to be silent and be cowards). It comes down to a choice between the power of intimidation and the power of a bold witness. Whichever looms larger to us will dictate our choices. Stephen traded his life for truth and a strong witness, and it was worth it. It always is.
